They are primeval forces of nature, both Terran and alien, walking out of the sea, the earth or the sky to wreak havoc on humanity - DAIKAIJU! (Literally, giant monsters.) Awakened by atomic tests or unscrupulous geniuses meddling with what they shouldn't, they cause wanton destruction and fight each other, often with strangely familiar wrestling moves - DAIKAIJU! Tremble in fear! Or better yet, run. Or perhaps... fight back? Err... DAIKAIJU!

DAIKAIJU CHARACTERS

Obviously, this playset is built for human (or humanish alien) characters. It simply wouldn't do to have players growl and screech in every scene they're in. And yet... And yet, you may want to do exactly that because while the human drama is where the story is, we watch kaiju films for the monster battles. Here's a suggestion as to how to balance humans and giant monsters in the same scenario:

During the set-up phase, players will need to build human characters, but one, several or all players could also decide they control a daikaiju. Once per act, add an additional monster scene in which the players who control monsters can act out a fight, random destruction, etc. Human characters can react to this, of course. Players can also choose to use their monster instead of their human character for a scene if the collaborative narrative warrants it, but should probably not do so more than once per game.

Monsters can use the same Relationships, Needs, Locations and Things as their human counterparts, and indeed, many in this playset were written with both "character sizes" in mind. When humans and monsters start to blur together, we call that *theme*.
